## PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

Physiotherapy is a health care profession concerned with human function and movement and maximising potential. It is concerned with identifying and maximising quality of life and movement potential within the spheres of promotion, prevention, treatment/intervention, habilitation and rehabilitation.

It uses physical approaches to promote, maintain and restore physical, psychological and social well-being, taking account of variations in health status. It is science-based, committed to extending, applying, evaluating and reviewing the evidence that underpins and informs its practice and delivery.

This program covers subjects like anatomy, physiology, exercise therapy, electrotherapy, musculoskeletal, neurological, cardio thoracic and other conditions in order to acquire the health education needed for prevention, diagnosis, treatment, rehabilitation, etc., of patients with physical problems.
