INTAKE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Intake: March, July, November

Entry Requirements:

- i. A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) with at least Grade C (GP 2.0) in any TWO subjects*; OR
- ii. A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with at least Grade Jayyid*; OR
- iii. Matriculation or Foundation with at least CGPA of 2.00; OR
- iv. A Diploma (Level 4, MQF) with at least CGPA of 2.00; OR
- v. An Advanced Diploma (Level 5, MQF) with at least CGPA of 2.00; OR
- vi. A Diploma Kemahiran Malaysia (DKM) / Diploma Vokasional Malaysia (DVM) subjected to Lincoln University College Senate / Academic Board's approval***; OR
- vii. A Diploma Lanjutan Kemahiran Malaysia (DLKM) subjected to Lincoln University College Senate / Academic Board's approval***; OR

English Competency Requirement (International Student)

Achieve a minimum Band 3 in Malaysian University English Test (MUET) OR equivalent to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) (Low B2).

Notes:

- *Additional requirement a pass in Mathematics and English at SPM level or equivalent qualifications with condition as below:
- Can be waived should any other higher qualifications contain Mathematics and English subjects with an equivalent/higher achievement.
- Malaysian students using English as the medium of instruction in their previous study or with at least Band 2 in MUET or equivalent can be exempted from a pass in English requirement.
- Those without a pass in Mathematics and/or English at SPM level or equivalent can be admitted but are required to attend special enhancement course(s). These special enhancement courses should be SPM equivalent, remedial in nature. Students must pass the Mathematics and English enhancement courses as a prerequisite to related core courses taught in English.
