PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

This curriculum prepares students for entry directly into the first year of a bachelor's degree programme. It is mostly a pre-university programme with a focus on the arts and humanities. 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INTAKE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Intake: January, May, September

Entry Requirements:

- i. Possess Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) with at least credits in 5 subjects; or
- ii. Pass Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) with at least grade B in 3 subjects; or
- iii. Pass O-Level with at least grade C in 5 subjects; or
- iv. Other equivalent qualification recognised by the Malaysian Government.

English Competency Requirement (International Student):

Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) of 500 or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) of 5.0 or any other equivalent qualification. If the student does not fulfil the above criteria, the Lincoln University College must offer English proficiency course to ensure that student is proficient in the language to the standard required for the program.
