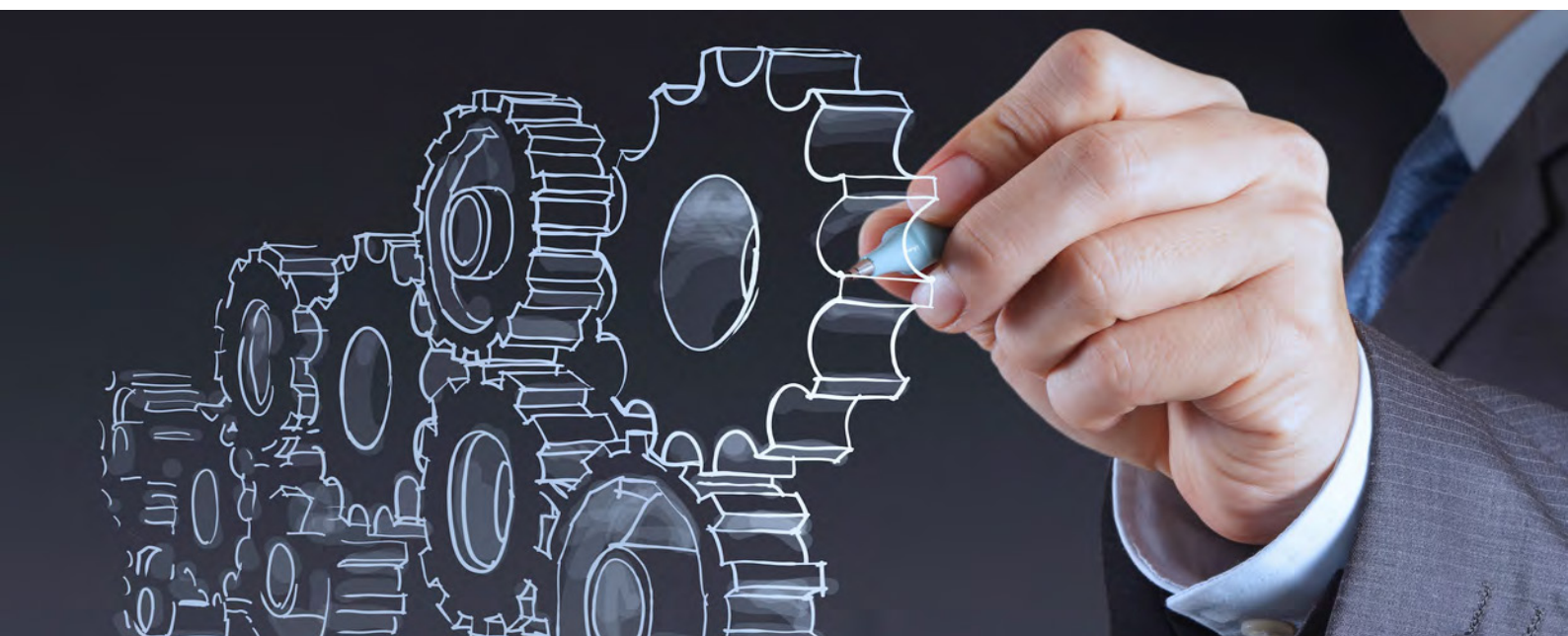




PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

Doctor of Philosophy in Dentistry is a doctorate that aims to learn about a significant area of medical research and to cover subjects including general dentistry, implants, and dental surgery. A doctoral degree offers excellent resources to support doctorates in cutting-edge research as well as to enable doctoral applicants to obtain experience in teaching and understand modern testing techniques. The curriculum emphasizes original research conducted under supervision, instructional courses, and the creation and presentation of a thesis.

For successful completion of PhD candidate should publish minimum four research articles in Scopus indexed journals, with Lincoln University College affiliation.



PROGRAMME AIM

The program Doctor of Philosophy in Dentistry will produce professionals who can be able to:

- ▶ Impart in-depth knowledge and critical understanding of dentistry including deeper insight into current research.

- ▶ Inculcate leadership quality for entrepreneurial works personally in dentistry tasks.

▶ **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- ▶ A master's degree in the field or related fields accepted by the Lincoln University College Senate; or
- ▶ Other qualifications equivalent to a master's degree recognized by the Government of Malaysia.
- ▶ Candidates without a related qualification in the field/s or working experience in the relevant fields must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the Lincoln University College.
- ▶ Bachelor of Dental Surgery or equivalent qualification; and
- ▶ Master's degree in dental sciences or equivalent qualification as required by Lincoln University College.
- ▶ This degree must have a total Student Learning Time (SLT) ranging from 1600–2000 hours. A minimum of 800–1000 hours of this degree must include among others a Registered with the MDC and holds current Annual Practicing Certificate (APC) or registered with the dental regulatory body in another country and eligible to be granted a Temporary Practicing Certificate (TPC) by MDC.
- ▶ A minimum of two (2) years clinical practice after basic degree, excluding the Master's training; and
- ▶ Health and other requirements as required by Lincoln University College.
- ▶ preclinical training component which contribute towards the specialty training.

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS :

International students must have proof of good proficiency in verbal and written English. For example, International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 5.0 or its equivalent. If a student does not meet this requirement, HEPs must offer English proficiency courses to ensure that the student's proficiency is sufficient to meet the needs of the programme.
