Entry Requirements:

- 1. A Bachelor's Degree [Level 6, Malaysian Qualifications Framework (MQF)] in Economics field with a minimum CGPA 2.50 out 4.00 or its equivalent qualifications as accepted by the HEP Senate; or
- 2. A Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, MQF) in Economics field with Mathematics with CGPA below 2.50 out of 4.00 or its equivalent qualification can be accepted, subject to a minimum of five (5) years of working experience in relevant field; or
- 3. Bachelor Degree (Level 6, MQF) in Business Management/Administration with Economics as Major module.
