iii. Any qualifications equivalent to to Diploma or Advanced Diploma with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 (Level 4 or 5, MQF); OR

iv. Matriculation / Foundation qualification with minimum CGPA of 2.00 out of 4.00 or any equivalent qualification
