### **INTAKE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

January, July, October

- Passed the Malaysian High School Certificate (STPM) by obtaining at least Grade C (CGPA 2.00) in 2 subjects; or
- A-Level pass with at least Grade C (2.00) in 2 subjects; or
- Passed Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) with at least Grade B in 5 subjects; or
- Passed Matriculation / Foundation / Foundation with at least 2.00; or
- Passed Diploma in related field with minimum CGPA of 2.00; or
- Route APEL Candidates must be 21 years or older in the year of application, have relevant working experience and pass judgment APEL conducted by MQA (PPT subject to the basic quota students APEL established that a maximum of 5% of the total population of students in a given time).
- Other recognized qualifications are equivalent to it by the Malaysian government.
