- Possess Diploma in Nursing (MQF Level 4) or its equivalent Minimum three (3) months working experience in public health
- Possess a Post Basic in Midwifery Registered with Nursing Board Malaysia
- Possess a current Annual Practicing Certificate (APC)

Option 2:

- Possess Diploma in Nursing (MQF Level 4) or its equivalent
- Possess a Post Basic in Public Health Nursing
- Registered with Nursing board Malaysia
- Possess a current Annual Practicing Certificate (APC)

ii For International Candidates

- Ç Possess Diploma in Nursing (MQF Level 4) or its equivalent
- Ç Minimum three (3) Years clinical working experience
- Ç Registered with Nursing Council or Board of country of origin
- Ç Possess a post basic in Public Health Nursing or Midwifery subject to approval of the Selection Committee of the University
- Possess a current Temporary Practicing Certificate (TPC) form Nursing Board Malaysia before clinical placement
- Pass International English Language Testing System (IELTS) with minimum score of 5.5 or Test of English as a Foreign Language as a medium of instruction.
