For successful completion of PhD candidate should publish minimum Four research articles in Scopus indexed journals, with Lincoln University College affiliation.

▶ ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

i. A bachelor's degree in psychology and master's degree in psychology at CGPA of 3.0 out of 4.0 or equivalent (Level 7, MQF) as accepted by the HEP Senate.

ii. Candidates with a bachelor's degree (non-psychology, Level 6, MQF) with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 and a master's degree in psychology with a minimum 45 credits of prerequisites modules in Psychology or a graduate diploma in Psychology or its equivalent as accepted by the HEP Senate;

OR

iii. Other relevant equivalent qualifications recognised by Malaysian government as equivalent to the above requirements.

English Requirements :

International students must have proof of good proficiency in verbal and written English. For example, the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 5.0 or its equivalent. If a student does not meet this requirement, HEPs must offer English proficiency courses to ensure that the student's proficiency is sufficient to meet the programme's needs.
